

Esmond Station Dress Code

We all share the responsibility of assuring the atmosphere is conducive to learning and fostering an environment of respect. Appropriate dress is often a requisite for employment and, therefore, is a topic consistent with meaningful instruction and relevant to student learning. Students are expected to dress appropriately for school. Students may be asked to change clothes if the clothing is deemed inappropriate by staff. Please adhere to the following:

Shoes:

Must be worn at all times

Slippers may not be worn to school except for special events

Skate shoes with wheels on the bottom, heels over 2 inches, and steel or otherwise reinforced hard-toe boots or shoes may NOT be worn at school

Pants:

Must be anchored or fitted at the waist and hemmed or tailored

Ripped denim that allows skin to show above mid thigh is NOT allowed

Must be visible and not completely covered by a shirt

Bike shorts/Spandex leggings are allowed as long as a shirt or blouse is worn mid thigh

Shorts and Skirts:

Must be anchored or fitted at the waist and hemmed or tailored

No shorter than mid thigh

Must be visible and not completely covered by a shirt/jacket

Bike shorts/Spandex leggings are allowed as long as a shirt or blouse is worn mid thigh

Tops, Shirts, and Sweatshirts:

No midriffs, half shirts, fishnet, see-through, strapless, halter tops or spaghetti straps

Stomach, sides, and cleavage should be covered

Tank tops must have a width of 2 fingers at the shoulder and not have excessive gaps under arms

All clothing and Accessories:

May not be worn with vulgar and/or violent messages or pictures, gang oriented insignias, or satanic/negative symbols, illegal substances, beer/alcohol, cigarettes, or otherwise inappropriate design

Undergarments may not be visible

Undershirts may not be worn as outer attire

Pajamas are not allowed except for special events

No gauges, nails, or safety pins may be worn in the ear.

Tattoos are NOT permitted

Chains and collars may NOT be worn as jewelry.

Belts must be entirely looped (no part of the belt may hang)

No wallet chains

1st Violation- Student will be sent to the Health Office to remedy the infraction. This may include wearing clothes provided by the school.

2nd Violation- Student will be sent to the Health Office to remedy the infraction. Parents will be notified and student may receive other disciplinary consequences, at the discretion of administration.

3rd Violation- Parents will be notified to pick-up student from school. This will count as an out of school suspension.
